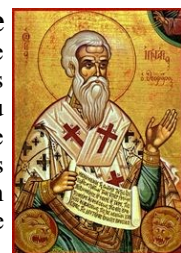


Saint of the Week:

October 17- **St. Ignatius of Antioch** (c.37-107) an apostolic father is believed to have been a convert to Christianity and a disciple of John the Evangelist. He served the community of Antioch as bishop for 40 years. He was arrested and sentenced to death in Rome during the anti-Christian reign of the Roman emperor Trajan because he would not engage in idol worship. The ship in which he was sent travelled along the coast of Asia Minor and at every port crowds of Christians would greet him. His journey was marked by extensive writing in which he composed seven letters, now counted among the treasures of early Christianity, emphasizing the humanity and divinity of Christ, the centrality of Eucharist, and the importance of Church unity. One reference to the saint's proclamation before his martyrdom of which he was devoured by lions states that he was the wheat of Christ, to be ground by the teeth of beasts.

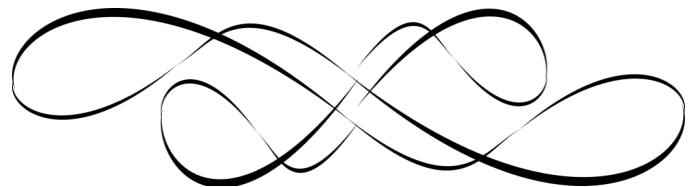
