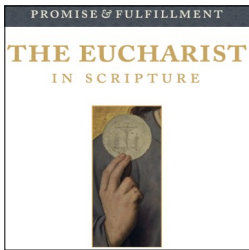

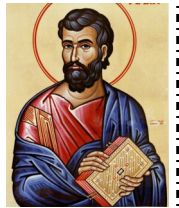

Saint of the Week:

April 25: **St. Mark** was a member of the first Christian community in Jerusalem. He was the author of the earliest and shortest account of the Gospel between 60 AD and 70 AD. Since Mark was close to Peter, Christians used Mark's mother's house there as a place of prayer during Peter's imprisonment under Herod Agrippa I (Acts 12:12). His simple and direct Gospel account was one of the main sources for the other evangelists. In Christian art Mark is often depicted with a winged lion. He is linked to the lion because his gospel opens with John the Baptist proclaiming "Prepare the way of the Lord", a voice described as mighty and urgent reminiscent of a lion's roar. Mark's portrayal of Jesus is very human and serves as a model for us to "go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature (Mark 16:15). He is a patron of notaries, of Egypt and Venice.

25 avril : **St Marc** (1^{er} siècle) Selon la tradition, les premiers chrétiens se réunissaient à Jérusalem dans la maison familiale de Marc. Celui-ci accompagna Paul et Barnabé en Asie mineure; il fut l'interprète de Pierre à Antioche puis à Rome. Il fut le premier à rédiger un évangile. Son évangile présente un choix de paroles et d'actions de Jésus, comme un résumé de la catéchèse primitive. On lui attribue la fondation de l'Église d'Alexandrie, en Égypte. Selon la tradition, il serait mort martyr à Alexandrie.

Diocesan Pastoral Council Spring Recruitment 2026

In 2022, Bishop Fabbro re-established the Diocesan Pastoral Council. It is a consultative body made up of mostly lay faithful and representatives of the Religious in the Diocese as well as deacons and priests. They act as an advisory council for the Bishop. The members of the Council identify pastoral needs, and with study, prayer, discernment, and dialogue, they present possible recommendations for the Bishop to consider. With the term of office ending for some current members, the Diocese is seeking new members (one representative from each deanery) who will be appointed to the Council to join in September 2026. In the coming months, there will be a series of recruitment meetings for those who may be interested in joining the Council. Please prayerfully consider attending one of the following meetings to get more information and how to submit your name (or another person) for consideration. Please keep this initiative in your prayers as the Church continues to respond to Pope Leo's first words from the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica, "We must seek together how to be a missionary Church." He reminds us to carry forward his predecessor's hallmark initiative, to engage each other in synodality, and to give a more prominent voice to the laity in future pastoral directions.

Truth and Reconciliation - 'Did you know'

Did you know this year marks the 150th anniversary of the Indian Act. The Indian Act was established on April 12, 1876. It defined who was and who was not an "Indian." An Indian agent was on or near reserves to enforce the Act and dictate daily living, such as permission to leave the reserve, participating in ceremonies and pow-wows, etc. It was the foundation for Canada's assimilation policy towards First Nations, Métis and Inuit. If you want to learn more about the Indian Act and myths surrounding it check out the book 21 Things You May Not Know About the Indian Act by Bob Joseph.

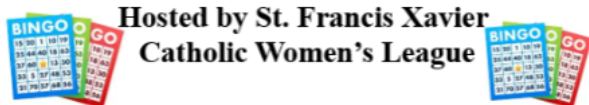

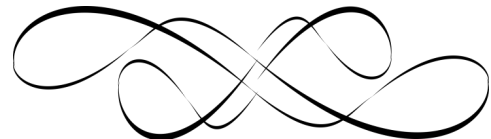
